Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions and any entry not complying with these Terms and Conditions is invalid.

To enter, entrants must:

1. Entry is open to Australian residents between the age of 12 and 25. Any entrant under the age of 18 years must have their parent or guardian's permission to enter the promotion. Employees of the Promoter and their immediate families are ineligible to enter.

2. Promotion commences at 10.00am Australian Eastern Daylight Time ("AEDT") on 10 December 2017 and closes at 10.00pm AEDT on Sunday 21 January 2018 2015 ("Promotion Period").

3. Visit the exhibition BOARD take a photo of themselves in front of the BOARD title wall in the exhibition.

Design your own graphic for a Surfboard or Skateboard and submit as a jpeg.

Share on Instagram with #BOARDlakemac to increase your chance in the people's choice award.

4. Entrants may enter the competition more than once, however each entry must be created by the entrant and cannot be the same. The artwork/design must be the artist/designer's own original work.

5. The artist must have visited the exhibition BOARD: surf and skate culture meet contemporary art at Lake Macquarie City Art Gallery between 10 December 2017 – 21 January 2018

6. By entering the competition the artist/designer agrees to have their artwork and photograph featured on all social media platforms, LMCAG website and in media.

7. This is a game of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winners. Each entry will be individually judged, based upon individual creative merit. All entries must be an independent creation by the entrant. Entries must not have been published previously and/or have been used to win prizes in any other competitions.

8. The major prize is a custom-made surfboard with your own design valued at \$ 1100 recommended retail price ("RRP").

9. The minor prize is a custom-made skateboard blank with your own design valued at \$ 350 recommended retail price ("RRP").

10. The people choice prize is gift voucher for Grundy's Surf and Skate valued at \$ 100 recommended retail price ("RRP").

11. Total prize pool for the promotion is valued at \$1550 RRP.

12. The entries will be judged at First Street Booragul 2284 on 22 January 2017.

13. The winners will be notified by telephone or email by Thursday 25 January 2017.
